Annual Bass Fishing Tournament

Where: Holiday Shores Marina, Lake Ozark, Mo. (see back of program for directions)
When: 7-11 a.m. (Leave Marina at 7:00 a.m. Sharp)
What: Guides furnished – two anglers per boat. Bring your own tackle and Missouri fishing license (required!).
Cost: \$155 per person (MLA members); \$205 per person (nonmembers). Fee covers bass boat and guide. Note: A discount is provided if a third person is added to standard two-person/one-guide boat.

FAQ:

- Are guides furnished? There is one guide provided per boat. (Two anglers to a boat, please.)
- Can we bring our own boat? Yes. (Guides, however, are not provided for those who bring their own boat and fees are the same.)
- Do we need any sort of license? A Missouri fishing license is required. There are many outlets in the Lake of the Ozarks area where you can purchase a license or you can purchase one online, 65 or above no permit required.
- Is tackle provided? It is highly recommended you bring your own. Bait and equipment is available, but any damages to borrowed equipment are the responsibility of the borrower.
- Do we fish if it rains? To a point. It is a “rain-or-shine” event. But, if high winds or lightning occur, the event could be canceled due to those conditions.
- What type of fish do we have to catch to qualify for a prize? You can catch and keep any type of fish you want as long as it meets the established size limits. Catch and release is the spirit of the event. Any type of bass and bass fish only are required to win a prize. Prizes awarded for largest three stringers and largest bass.

When: 2:00 p.m.
Format: 3 Game Sweeper - 9 Pin Tournament.
Cost: \$25 per person
Prizes awarded for Top Three positions.

DIRECTIONS TO HOLIDAY SHORES RESORT: Please note, the turn-off is easy to miss!

Coming from east to west on Hwy 54: Go ½ mile west of the Bus. 54 exit. Look to the north and you’ll see the Ozark Opry. At that location is Mace Rd. Turn right (north) and go approx. ¼ mile to Orville St. You’ll see a sign pointing the direction to the Holiday Shores Resort.

Coming from west to east on Hwy 54: Go approx. 8/10 mile past Mo. Hwy. 42 (turnoff to Bear Creek Valley Golf Course). Look to the north and you will see the Ozark Opry. At that location is Mace Rd. Turn left (north) and go approx. ¼ mile to Orville St. You’ll see a sign pointing the direction to the Holiday Shores Resort.

By water, Holiday Shores is located at the 17 mile marker in Pogue Hollow Cove.
